

- Courses to be offered in Summer School are announced on the Summer School website as of January. The course list is added to BUIS as "Schedule Period 3" after the Spring semester withdraw period.

- Courses cannot be selected in Summer School without fulfilling the payment obligation. The payment system opens two to three weeks before the pre-registration period and closes on the day the system closes for student access.
- **Calculation:** The payment amount can be calculated using the "Summer Payment Calculator" on BUIS.
- **Payment Method:** Payments are made via Garanti BBVA (Online, ATM, or Branch) using the student ID.
- **YKA:** Application Fee (Yaz Okulu Kayıt Ücr.).
- **YKR:** Credit Fee (Yaz Okulu Kredi Ücr.).
- **Note:** IBAN numbers are not shared, and transfers/EFTs are not accepted

- Students who have completed their payment can log in to BUIS and select courses. Course selection is performed under the "Course List Preparation" tool.
- The **Summer School scholarship** covers the fee of the highest-cost course among your selections. If you are taking only one course, it is sufficient to pay only the application fee (YKA). If you take more than one course, you are required to pay the application fee (YKA) plus the fees for the other (lower-cost) courses.
- During course selection, different quota information may be encountered. This is visible in the quota field on the course schedule.

-1	Consent of Instructor	Each student requires the consent of the academic staff. For that, each student needs to send a "consent request" through the system. The academic staff can reject or accept the student's request. The accepted student needs to add the course to their program; the course is not added to the student's program automatically. Rejected and non-responded students cannot add the course.
1000	Unlimited	The course is open to all student.
Specific Number	Restricted Quota	The course capacity is limited. Additional students wishing to enroll will need consent from the academic staff. For that, each student needs to send a "consent request" through the system. The academic staff can reject or accept the student's request. The accepted student needs to add the course to their program; the course is not added to the student's program automatically. Rejected and non-responded students cannot add the course.

- **24-Hour Rule:** Courses approved via consent must be added to the program by the student within 24 hours; otherwise, a new request is required

RECOMMENDATIONS

- Check the consent status before following the flowchart steps. **Consent** implies a restriction defined by the instructor (regarding student number or profile).
- Programs created during pre-registration are sent for advisor approval during the Final Registration period. It is recommended to contact your advisor early.
